

# ArtsVote in New York

Updated as of 6/22/24)



#### Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024

## **CONFIRM:** Pre-Requisites

- Be a United States citizen
- Be 18 years old by the date of the election
- Be a resident of New York and the county, city or village for at least 30 days before the election
- Not currently in prison for a felony conviction
- Not claiming the right to vote elsewhere
- Not declared mentally incompetent by a court of law

## **STEP 1:** Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or **Register to Vote** for the first time by <u>mail</u>, <u>in-person</u>, or <u>online</u>. (You can only register to vote online if you have an NY.Gov ID and it must be done by **Saturday**, **October 26**, **2026**.) All **mailed** registrations must be signed (by hand, not virtually) and RECEIVED by your county board of elections by **Saturday**, **October 26**, **2024** to be eligible to vote. If registering **in-person**, you must submit your registration at your local board of elections office or any state agency any New York State <u>Agency-Based voter registration center</u> by **Saturday**, **October 24**, **2024**. (<u>NOTE</u>: If you do not meet one of these registration requirements, you will not be eligible to vote on Election Day). **Don't delay**, **pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Friday October 11, 2024.** 

### **STEP 2: Request Your Early Mail Ballot** (If Preferred)

Any register voter can apply for an <u>Early Mail Ballot</u> but voters can only vote by <u>absentee ballots</u> if they <u>meet one</u> of the approved <u>specific requirements</u>. There are <u>four ways to apply</u> for an early mail ballot or an absentee ballot. 1) You can <u>apply online</u> using the <u>Application Portal</u>. 2) If you are <u>visually impaired</u> and require a ballot with accessible features you may <u>apply online</u> using the <u>Accessible Ballot Application Portal</u>. 3) <u>Apply in-person</u> at your local <u>county board of elections</u>. 4) Designate another person to deliver your application <u>in-person</u> to your local county board of elections office and retrieve your ballot. If you request an mail ballot <u>online or by mail</u>, it must be submitted/RECEIVED by the board of elections in your county by <u>Saturday</u>, <u>October 26</u>, <u>2024</u>. For ballot requests submitted <u>in-person</u>, applications must be RECEIVED by your board of elections no later than <u>Monday</u>, <u>November 4</u>, <u>2024</u>. If you need to vote by absentee ballot, pledge to submit your absentee ballot application by Friday, October 11, 2024.

#### **STEP 3: Cast Your Vote**

ABSENTEE BALLOTS: Completed <u>mail ballots</u> can be **submitted four ways**. You can 1) put it in the mail ensuring it is POSTMARKED no later than **Tuesday, November 5, 2024**. 2) Bring your completed ballot to your <u>County Board of Elections Office</u> no later than **Tuesday, November 5, 2024** by **9:00pm**. 3) Bring your completed ballot to an Early Voting <u>poll site</u> in your county between **Saturday, October 26, 2024** and **Sunday, November 3, 2024**. 4) Bring your completed ballot to a <u>poll site</u> or your county board of elections on **Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024** by **9:00pm**. Be sure to follow the very <u>specific absentee ballot requirements</u> and instructions carefully. **Don't delay, pledge to mail-in your completed absentee ballot by Friday, October 25, 2024**.

- OR -

**IN-PERSON VOTING: Early Voting** begins **Saturday, October 26, 2024** and continues through **Sunday, November 3, 2024**. Each voting site has different hours, so check <u>here</u> to determine the best voting site for you. On **Election Day**, check your for your local polling location's hours <u>here</u>. You can find your <u>polling location</u> on the New York Board of Elections website. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. **Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote during Early Voting.** 

### **STEP 4: Celebrate Your Vote**

**Celebrate** being an ArtsVote leader by posting a selfie of you mailing-in your ballot or wearing an "I Voted" sticker on social media.
